# **About the Grant**

The BSEC PERMIS was approved by DG NEAR to receive a direct grant under the *EU Regional Action Program*, with the aim to strengthen the project implementation capacity of the BSEC Organization and its role as facilitator of dialog and cooperation in the region.

**Areas of work**: <u>transport</u> (Sustainable Small-Scale Cruising/Yachting in the Black Sea), <u>environmental protection</u> (Pilot Activities on Fighting Micro Plastics and Marine Litter in the Black Sea) and <u>youth entrepreneurship</u> (Supporting Youth Entrepreneurship in Cultural Tourism for coastal communities in the Black Sea Region).

**Grant Contract ENI/2020/421-957** was signed on 28.12.2020. Two-years project, which commenced on 1 January 2021.







### **Aim, Target Groups, Partners**

**Aim:** contributes to the regional dialogue on mitigating and effectively tackling marine pollution and marine litter in the Black Sea, while at the same time seeking innovative solutions to salient problems

- creation of an educational school kit
